What types of work will I do?

Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) support everyday tasks like personal care, cooking, employment, and transportation.

These jobs are similar to other care jobs, such as working as a Home Health Aide, Certified Nursing Assistant, or a Personal Care Assistant. The biggest difference is that you will be working at a Rise site or at an employer, instead of working at someone's home, in a long-term care facility, or in a hospital.

Life Enrichment DSP Supported Employment Teams DSP Consultant

Life Enrichment DSP:

Support adults with disabilities taking part in fun activities like art and music therapy, cooking classes, YMCA events, and community outings.

Supported Employment DSP:

Assist small groups of adults at their jobs in the community. You'll figure out how to teach each task, write reports, and keep track of progress. You'll also oversee daily activities at the job sites to make sure everything runs smoothly. Requires Driving.

Employment Consultant:

Coach people to find and keep jobs while building goal-setting and job searching skills. You'll build strong connections with employers and people we serve by networking and showcasing the strengths of Rise and the people we support, creating successful job paths for people.
